


Interviewing Principal Cheng

Q1: Principal Cheng, would you like to share some of your successful learning experiences with us?

Principal: I think the English learning experience is quite inspiring for me because when I was a secondary 1 student, I was in a very famous boarding school in Hong Kong. The students over there were very smart and their English ability was much higher than mine. So in the first year, I found I was left far behind them. But I really wanted to enter the Chinese University in Hong Kong. So learning English was the most important part of my school life. I tried to use a lot of different ways to improve my English. For example, when I was in form 2, I tried to take part in some solo speech competitions. And I found a foreigner and English teachers to help me. Every night, I spent more than one hour practising my English like reading English books and doing some comprehension exercises to learn more vocabulary. Throughout the whole 5 years, learning English was the most crucial thing for me. Because I'm a Chinese, I had to grab more opportunities to learn English.

Q2: Was there any hard time in your learning experience?

Principal: Yes, of course. For example, I love English but as I said that I'm a Chinese, so I didn't have a lot of opportunities to be exposed to English in my life, and also I was in the dormitory, which meant I couldn't go out to see the world of English. In those years, the English standard of the society was not that high. Nowadays I can use the Internet to communicate, but at that time I could just listen to the radio because in the dormitory we did not have TV. So I think the hard time is that there were not enough resources, not enough time and also not enough chance to encounter English.

Q3: Can you share some tips or some interesting ways for our students to learn a language?

Principal: I remember that 10 years ago, I was already a teacher. When I tried to learn Putonghua, I spent 4 years. Some poor experience or some jokes happened when I spoke Putonghua in mainland China, so I decided to learn mandarin by immersion. First, I took part in two examinations to force myself to learn and find some very good teachers, for example, my Putonghua teacher was a broadcaster in Beijing. She speaks Putonghua so well. Moreover, when I drove every day, I listened to the Putonghua news. So I think the tip to learn a language - you should try to immerse yourself in the environment of learning language activities. Also, I tried to type 'pinyin' during that period.

Q4: What is the best way for students to improve their English?

Principal: first, I think, it is to learn from errors. Even now, I still find that I make lots of grammar mistakes when speaking, but that's not a problem because the communication is the most important part. So even if I have a lot of errors, I will try to be aware of that and try to learn from them. Second, learn from others. Some students learn English by asking their classmates how to learn English. The last one is try to work hard. I remember that when I was in secondary 5, I finished plenty of English exercises from 5 books. After doing the exercises, I would pick up some vocabulary items which I didn't know and record them in my notes to see if I could use them.

Q5: What do you think of our schoolmates?

Principal: Full of love and teachable. I think all Wing Lung students are nice and love our environment. We have a certain amount of talent to learn better, but do not have enough confidence. We also do not have a strong passion to learn more. So I think I need to set an example, try to be more passionate in my learning.



Q6: How to create a good attitude towards learning?

Principal: First of all, students should have a target in their learning.

For example, getting a place in the university or limiting yourself to learn something in a period of time. For me, I just limited myself to learning Putonghua in 4 years with a lot of practice. Next, students should have some tactics. I have learned ice skating before. I spent two times every week, every time one hour. Just keep practising repeatedly. And the last is passion. It is important for students to keep their passion in learning.

Q7: How to reduce the stress of studying?

Principal: Since I wanted to enter the university when I was in secondary school, I would spend some time relaxing. For example, I like singing. When I was in the dormitory, I would sing very loudly, even others could hear. Also, I like jogging and listening to music. Therefore, I just brought a big speaker to enjoy the music and learned English from listening to lyrics. Moreover, when I had a very stressful situation, I would try to throw all the work away and be alone to calm myself down. It is because constantly forcing yourself cannot help you. I would go to to watch my favorite drama or go jogging, just to relax myself in my own way.

Q8: How did you manage your learning schedule?

Principal: I learned time management when I was very young. For example, when I was in secondary school, I would write down all the things I had to do in a tight schedule. I would set a target every week or every two weeks. When I completed one of the targets, I would reward myself in a logical way such as sticking a sticker on the schedule book. Nowadays, I will use the google calendar. Since I have lots of work to do, I will write or type my schedule as detailed as possible. Even the time I start jogging and the time I need to go home. In addition, I will use color markers to classify my work. For example, the things that I highlight in red color are the tasks that I must do. And the pink or purple one is the events of my church or family. So it is useful for students to plan in advance when they are going to have a schedule. Because I am a principal now, if I do not plan my work well, I cannot achieve any goals.

Q9: Do you think that a place in the university is the only way to be successful?

Principal: Of course not. We can see that there are a lot of successful people who have not been in university. The most important thing is what you think of success. For me, working out a meaningful life is a success. For students, if they find their target, like being a cook or a fashion designer, it is not necessary for them to enter a university. Try to realize their dream is already successful. Most students think that to enter a university reflects a successful life. However, if students just waste their time in university, it is not a success. University education is just the quickest way to be a little bit more successful.



Q10: As a new principal, what is your expectation in the future years?

Principal: We have a new slogan this year. The goals are trying to nurture the student's life and helping them to become valuable people. For me, I hope I can be more familiar with the work of a principal and try to know more about my students. In the coming two years, I hope I can enter more classrooms to enjoy the school life with students. I also hope that my students can embrace learning and try to learn more. I have also planned to teach as well; I hope I can handle the work of the principal and the work of a teacher. However, it is just planning because maybe I must have a lot of challenges to face. Anyway, I always love sharing in the classroom with my students.

We decorated the flowers with ribbons and lace. It was time to express our love to our LOVERS, I mean our mom and dad!




16 Mar --- Easter Egg Hunt (Board Game)

If you really don't like J-pop...never mind, here is the K-pop corner~




